WHY IN NEWS?

3. ST Status & Religious Conversion: The Ongoing Debate

WHY IN NEWS?

Political and social demands have recently been raised to formally delist tribals who convert to Christianity or Islam from the official Scheduled Tribe (ST) list, sparking an intense constitutional and sociological debate.

- **Evaluation Need:** There is a growing consensus on the need for clear, objective criteria and case-by-case examinations to address grievances related to reservation benefits.

- Develop clear, legally sound, and objective criteria for evaluating tribal status post-conversion.
- Ensure all policy decisions are rooted in evidence-based sociological assessments rather than political rhetoric.
- Protect genuine and traditional tribal rights while simultaneously ensuring overarching social justice and equitable resource distribution.

5. Padma Barrage Project, Bangladesh

WHY IN NEWS?

The Government of Bangladesh has officially approved the massive Padma Barrage Project on the Padma River, primarily aimed at addressing severe regional water scarcity and boosting agricultural output.

KEY FEATURES

- **Infrastructure Scale:** A massive 2.1 km long barrage equipped with 78 control gates.
- **Comprehensive Design:** The project includes integrated navigation locks, dedicated fish passages, undersluices for silt management, and extensive protective embankments.
- **Resource Capacity:** Designed to hold approximately 2.9 billion cubic metres of water.
- **Multi-purpose Utility:** Expected to generate 113 MW of hydropower and provide vital irrigation for around 2.88 million hectares of agricultural land.

ECOLOGICAL CONCERNS

- Potential drastic alteration of natural sediment flow, which could destabilize downstream delta ecosystems.
- Severe negative impact on migratory fish patterns and overall riverine biodiversity.

6. JWST Captures Weather on Exoplanet 700 Lightyears Away

WHY IN NEWS?

NASA's James Webb Space Telescope (JWST) has successfully detected and analyzed highly dynamic weather patterns on the distant exoplanet WASP-94Ab, showcasing the telescope's unprecedented observational power.

KEY FINDINGS

- **Planet Profile:** WASP-94Ab is classified as a Gas Giant (specifically a "Hot Jupiter"), located approximately 700 lightyears away from Earth.
- **Tidal Locking:** The planet is tidally locked to its host star, meaning one side experiences perpetual blistering heat (day side), while the other is in permanent cold darkness (night side).
- **Exotic Atmosphere:** Advanced spectroscopy revealed complex clouds composed of magnesium silicate, iron, and magnesium sulphide.
- **Extreme Weather:** Observations indicate phenomenally strong supersonic winds that constantly move atmospheric material from the scorching day side to the cooler night side.
- **Methodology:** These groundbreaking discoveries were made using high-resolution transmission spectroscopy, which analyzes the starlight filtering through the planet's atmosphere.

7. Indian Prisons Continue to be Overcrowded by Undertrials

WHY IN NEWS?

The latest National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) Prison Statistics Report 2024 brings to light the persistent, severe issue of overcrowding in Indian correctional facilities, driven largely by high undertrial populations.

KEY FACTS & STATISTICS

- **Capacity vs. Reality:** India currently has 1,333 prisons with a sanctioned capacity of 4.53 lakh inmates, but as of 2024, they house over 5.11 lakh inmates.
- **Undertrial Crisis:** A staggering 72.6% of all incarcerated inmates are undertrials (individuals awaiting or undergoing trial who have not been convicted).
- **Regional Extremes:** Delhi reports an alarming occupancy rate of 194%, while Jammu & Kashmir exceeds 140%.

- Urgently improve staffing levels and pivot focus toward meaningful inmate rehabilitation and skill-development programmes.
